

Guide line for completion of the concept paper

1. The proposed research concept should necessarily be an original.
2. Problem to be tackled or new knowledge to be generated should be clearly identified.
3. Research proposals which address inter-disciplinary work require having expertise from each of the different relevant disciplines, and be supported with letters of consent from such collaborators, if any (Annex III).
4. A scientist is eligible to hold only one ongoing grant as the Principal Investigator and four as the Co-Investigator. Applicants who have one ongoing grant should not apply for a new grant, until the Final Report of the previous grant is submitted.
5. Only one grant will be awarded to an Investigator as the Principal Investigator at this call for applications.
6. Softcopy of the application should be sent as a document format (.doc) and as a PDF format also.
7. Detail research proposals will be called from selected research concepts for further evaluation. Selected proposals will be recommended for funding by the General Treasury through the Ministry of Agriculture.
8. National Policy Framework Vistas of Prosperity and Splendour is available on the website of the Finance Ministry
9. Please note that the decision of the SLCARP is final.
